Castle Kilbride is gradually returning to pre-pandemic levels and offered a full slate of events in 2023. Of note, was the return of "Ghost Walks" which sold out for all 10 evenings, tea and tours, Christmas at the Castle as well as the always popular Castle Concert Series.
